The professional and private life of John William Sanger, P. Eng. is a record of service to the people of Manitoba.

Throughout his forty-five years of service with the City of Winnipeg Hydro Electric System, J. W. Sanger made many contributions as Chief Engineer and as General Manager to the efficient operation of the System. He served as a Commission Member of The Manitoba Power Commission for thirteen years, was a Member of the Manitoba Rural Electrification Enquiry Commission and a Member of The Manitoba Hydro-Electric Board. He was appointed National Sea Cadet Chairman of the Navy League of Canada during the years 1942 to 1945, and since 1951 has been a Member of the Board of the Winnipeg Children's Hospital. "For distinguished public service," the Honourary Degree of Doctor of Laws was conferred upon J. W. Sanger by The University of Manitoba on May 12, 1959.

His interest in furthering the professional status of engineers is one of long standing. He is a member of The Engineering Institute of Canada and the Association of Professional Engineers of the Province of Manitoba of which he was President 1932-1933.
