Leonard Arthur Bateman has devoted his engineering career to the production of power in the Province of Manitoba. From 1942 to 1956 Mr. Bateman was responsible for design and operation with the City of Winnipeg Hydro Electric System and held the position of General Superintendent in charge of power production at the time of his resignation. In 1956 he joined the Manitoba Hydro Electric Board and held various positions in that organization until his present position as Chairman and Chief Executive Officer.

Through the years Mr. Bateman has been an active member of many organizations. He has been chairman of several committees of the Canadian Electrical Association and is currently a Director. He is a member of the Canadian National Committee, World Energy Conference and a member of the Executive Committee, C.N.C. International Conference on Large Electric Systems.

He represented Canada at the World Power Conference in Moscow in August 1968, participating in round table discussions on D.C. Transmission and its role in world power systems. He is the official Canadian delegate on Study Committee Number 14 at CIGRE meetings.

For his contribution to the production of power this recognition is extended to Leonard Bateman.
