lan thanked Council for the opportunity to speak on the topic of Geophysical Surveys for unmarked graves at residential school sites in Manitoba.

lan reviewed the geoscience-related components in the search for unmarked graves, including database development, area mapping, sub-surface remote sensing, and communication of the results. He provided examples of GPR surveys and spoke of the development of recommendations and standards for unmarked grave searches. He then spoke of the Sandy Bay Residential School Project and provided a summary of the project's preliminary GPR survey results.
