The Accreditation Board accredits undergraduate engineering programs to ensure they provide the academic requirements for professional licensure in Canada.

The Canadian Engineering Accreditation Board Visiting Team is made up of at least one General Visitor who is a professional engineer within the region, who is not currently employed in an academic environment. Their purpose is to provide a broader perspective to the evaluation of the engineering education offered by the institution being reviewed, and to provide the views of their regulator to the visiting team and institution.

Specific Skills and Qualifications

- Be an experienced professional member in good standing with the Association
- Should not be employed full time in the academic environment
- Must be proficient in English, both written and spoken
- Have no conflict of interest in participating in the accreditation visits

Time Commitment:

There will be no regular meetings for this opportunity and the volunteers would only be required should they be called upon by Engineers Canada Accreditation Board Secretariat.
