## LIFE MEMBERSHIP

According to By-law 31 of the Association, Life Membership, Honoris Causa, may be granted by unanimous decision of Council to a member who has, in the opinion of Council, rendered meritorious service to the Association, who is no longer practising on a full-time basis as a Professional Engineer, and who has preferably been continuously a member for not less than 35 years and has attained the age of 65.

Edward Stairs Magill was registered in the Association in 1931. He served for two years on the Committee to Study the Act, for 6 years on the Legislation Committee and for 6 years on the Board of Examiners.
