Richard Henderson (Dick) Russell was born in Souris, Manitoba, in 1925. He graduated from the University of Manitoba in 1950 with a degree in Civil Engineering.

He was registered in this Association on February 23, 1955. In 1959 he transformed his membership to the Association of Professional Engineers of Saskatchewan and in 1964 to the Order of Engineers of Quebec, returning to the APEM in 1971.

After graduation Dick began practising engineering with Dominion Bridge where he moved through a succession of assignments of increasing responsibility in Winnipeg, Regina and Montreal, eventually holding senior positions in engineering and marketing.

His contributions to APEM began in 1956 when he served on the Public Relations Committee for four years. He then served on the Practice and Ethics Committee (now known as the Investigation Committee) for eleven years and the Ad Hoc Committee on Engineering Inspection and Supervision for one year.

In addition to his activities in APEM, Dick was Chairman of the University of Manitoba Engineering Endowment Fund Advisory Committee ending a six year term last year.

Dick retired in 1990 after active membership in Canadian Associations for 35 years and the APEM for 28 years.

Honorary Life Membership is granted to Dick Russell in recognition of the service he has provided to the Association and to the profession in Canada.
