Key Responsibilities:

- **Project Leadership**: Evaluate, prioritize, and manage capital projects from concept to completion, including budgeting, scheduling, procurement, and vendor management.
- Project Roles:

 - Serve as Self-Perform General Contractor on moderate scope projects.
 - o Represent True North as Owner's Representative for large-scale initiatives.
- **Design & Brand Standards:** Ensure all projects align with organizational branding and venue design standards.
- **Compliance:** Maintain adherence to all safety, permitting, building codes, and regulatory requirements.
- **Stakeholder Collaboration:** Liaise with internal teams, external contractors, and vendors to keep projects on track and aligned with True North's strategic goals.
- **Reporting & Administration:** Track budgets, monitor progress, oversee contracts, and provide timely project updates.
