NOMINATING COMMITTEE

The Nominating Committee is a committee of Council, which assists in identifying election candidates who meet the criteria for new councillors as described in the Governance Policy for Councillor Roles and Job Description, GP-6.

General Duties and Responsibilities

- Produce a slate of qualified candidates for Council election for review at the June Council
 meeting, that is in a manner consistent with the Act and By-laws, taking into consideration
 the broadest possible diversity of the membership.
- Contact potential candidates to explain the role of the councillor, the election processes, time commitments, and other related details.
- Report back to the committee whether potential candidates are willing to stand for election should the committee select them as a preferred candidate.

Specific Skills and Qualifications

- Be a professional geoscientist (P.Geo.) in good standing with the Association
- Candidates should have a well-connected network with other professional members.
- Candidates should have a basic understanding of governance, succession planning, and board/Council functions.
- Experience in the field of Human Resources, (i.e., screening applicants, interviewing, and selection) is preferred but not required.

Time Commitment:

The position would be for a one-year term, with the committee meeting approximately four to five times between the months of February and June.
